Thank you so much to all the parents and carers who attended our Parent Consultations on Tuesday.

Some facts about this week's parent consultations.

- 82% of children had an appointment booked by their parent/guardian
- 18% of children did not have an appointment booked by a parent/guardian

Of the appointments booked ...

89% of parents attended which means that 11% of parents did not attend who booked an appointment.

In total, 75% of children had a parent/guardian attend to find out about how they have settled into the new school year and how we can work together to support their child and 25% of children did not have a parent/guardian attend.
