Pupils with SEND

Each term we meet with parents whose children have Special Educational Needs which require school intervention and targets.

This term, we are going to try a new way to ensure that all parents are able to share their voice on their child's outcomes.

On **Friday 21**st **March**, we will send home the SEND review report which highlights what we are pleased about, what works well, what concerns we have and what we will do to support your child over the next term.

Parents will be asked to complete the Parent/carer box and return the paperwork to the class teacher, signed by **Friday 28**th **March**.

If you have received paperwork on Friday 21st March and would still like an appointment to discuss the report with the teacher, we will have a **SEND parent session on Monday 31st March** between 8:30 – 11:30am. If your child has had a SEND report sent home, you will be able to can book an appointment on Arbor between Friday 21st March – Thursday 27th March by 5pm.

If you are unable to book an appointment this means we have no further information to share with you at this time. This tends to be for children who we are awaiting support/advice or diagnosis for.

We are hoping that this will mean we will have more parental feedback regarding your child in a way that is more convenient to you.

Gates open at 8:45am and close at 8:50am. After 8:50 pupils must enter through the office as late.






WELLBEING STARS
